Sermon Title: Cultivating Intimacy with Christ in a New Year

Scripture: John 15:1-17

Main Idea: Abide in Christ by Continuing Fellowship in His Word and Keeping His Commandments.

OUTLINE

- 1. Jesus is the "true vine" and the Father is the "vine-dresser."
- 2. Continue fellowship in God's Word and keep His commandments
- Approach 2025 with a similar mindset as the Father: as a vine-dresser cutting back (cleaning up) what is not bearing fruit in keeping with righteousness and pruning what is bearing godly fruit according to the Word.

- 4. Pastor Matt's main idea/proposition was Abide in Christ by Continuing Fellowship in His Word and Keeping His Commandments. Keep this in mind as you work through this guide.
